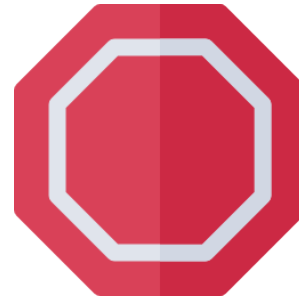


Important Information Please Read Carefully



Information on Practices:

Attendance

- Must attend **3 practices per discipline**.
- **Advanced Shotgun** requires a combination of 3 Skeet/Sporting Clays practices.
- Practices **MUST** be completed by **July 9, 2018** (no exceptions) to participate at the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition.

Age Requirements

- Any 4-H Member under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian over the age of 21.
- A 16-year-old member **CANNOT** bring underaged siblings.

Locations

- Official Practice Sites: **Ft. Lupton** (South Platte Valley Historical Society Range), **Galeton** (Weld County Fish and Wildlife Range), **Grover**, and **Colorado Clays**

Practice Cards

- **Your practice card MUST be brought to each practice** to get a stamp from a Range Leader.
- **YOU are responsible for getting stamps on your practice card!** It is proof that you attended a practice. No other proof exists.
- If lost, a new card can be received from the Weld County Extension Office.
- **Come to practice even if the weather is not good.** Colorado weather changes fast and could improve at any moment. If you come and the practice gets rained out, you will still **receive a stamp and credit for the practice.**

Galeton Waiver:

All persons entering the Galeton range must sign a waiver to be on the property. You may be asked to sign a waiver multiple times. When asked to sign, you will need to sign or leave the range.

Suggestion:

Take a picture of your card **EACH TIME** you get a stamp in case it gets lost. No stamps will be reissued without proof.

Hunter Safety

- You may come to practices even if you have not yet taken your Hunter Education Class.
- However, you **CANNOT** compete at the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition without it.

Safety Day Training

- You **MUST** attend Safety Day for **EACH** discipline
- Participants can only get training for **1 DISCIPLINE** at each Safety Day Training
- Those new to Weld County 4-H shooting sports must attend the morning session in Greeley or the Keenesburg training; returning members adding a discipline can come to any of the trainings

Important Discipline Specific Information

Shotgun:

- Prices will be:
 - \$5.00 per round at Galeton, Grover, and Colorado Clays
 - \$25 per 100 rounds for Sporting Clays at Galeton

.22 Pistol:

- ✎ Participants **MUST** be enrolled as a **SENIOR** to participate in this discipline
- ✎ You **MUST** have attended a .22 Pistol Safety Day to participate
- ✎ We will be using **TWO RULEBOOKS** for this class
 - Weld County Smallbore Pistol rules/requirements can be found at the Weld 4-H site (www.Weld4h.org). This rulebook that will be used to determine eligibility requirements for this class.
 - The State rules can be found at the state site: (www.co4hshooting.org).
- ✎ You **MUST** have a signed permission slip with you **at all times** while at the range. The example required slip can be found at the end of the Weld County Rulebook.

Weld County Shooting Sports Competition (County Shoot)

July 14-15, 2018

Registration:

- ✎ The Weld County Shooting Sports Competition (often called the County Shoot) and the Weld County Fair and are two different events
- ✎ **You will need to register separately** for the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition AND the Weld County Fair/Interview Judging entries

Weld County Shooting Sports Competition (County Shoot)

Registration:

- ✎ **Due Thursday, July 5, 2018**
 - Entries are accepted until 5:00p.m. Monday, July 9 with a \$5.00 per event late fee
 - NO entries are accepted after 5:00p.m. on July 9 OR the day of County Shoot
- ✎ Competition entry information will be **emailed** out in May
- ✎ Entries **MUST** include your practice log showing 3 stamped practices for each discipline you plan to shoot

Weld County Fair/Interview Judging Registration:

- ✎ Register for your project displays and interview judging at www.Weld4h.org AND www.weldcountyfair.com
- ✎ Entries are due on **JULY 6, 2018**
- ✎ You must complete and exhibit a project to complete your project for the year and be eligible for the 2018 State Shoot and the 2019 competitions.
- ✎ Fair Book will be **mailed** out in May from the extension office.

Important Information:

- ✎ There will NOT be an early County Shoot. County Shoot will be **July 14-15, 2018 ONLY**.
- ✎ If you are eligible to compete in the state contest, your display project **MUST** be exhibited at the **Weld County Fair in Greeley**.
- ✎ There will be **open practices** at Ft. Lupton/Grover **July 10, 2018** and Galetton **July 12, 2018**, but they will **NOT count as one of your 3 required practices**.
