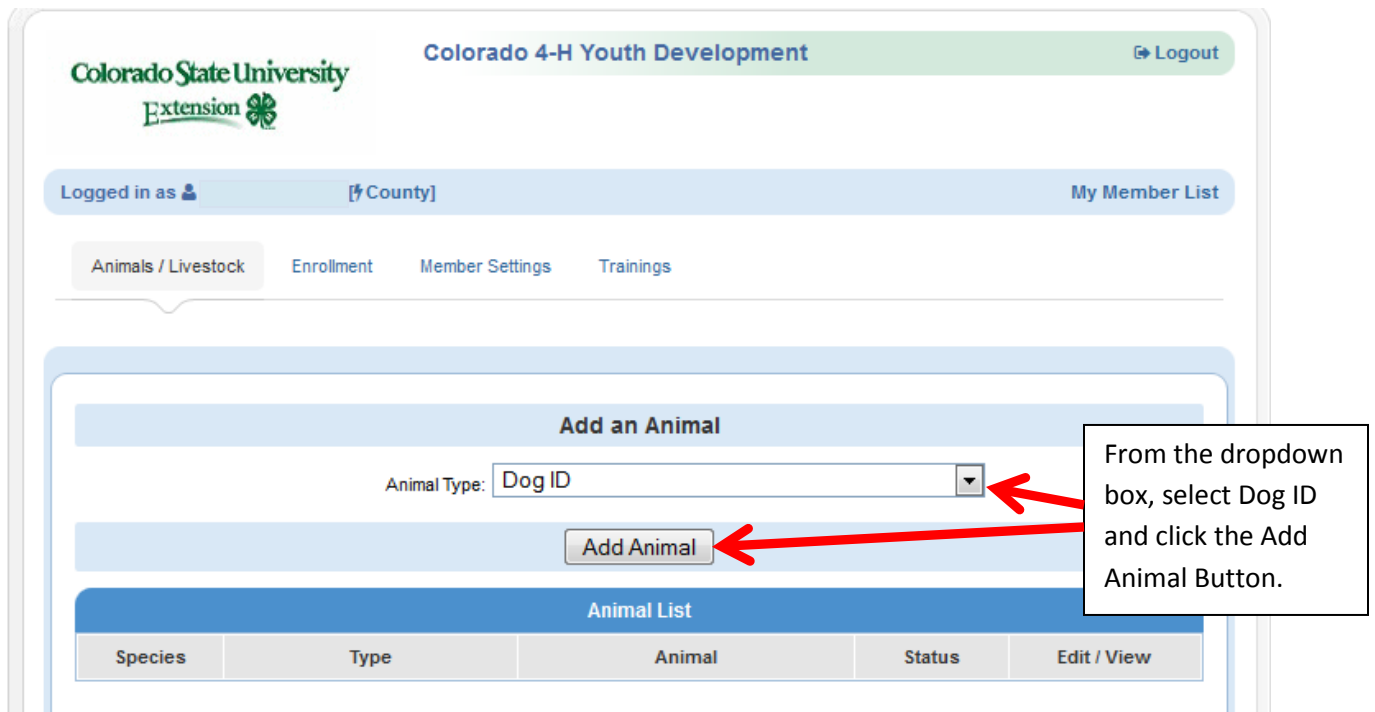


Dog ID Entry Online instructions for Members

All dogs you want to use this current year must be entered through 4-H Online. This includes any dog ID's from previous years. The Weld County deadline for the **Dog ID Form is May 1st of each year**. 4-H Online will remember all of the Dog ID's you have entered. You will need to edit the age of the dog every year.

From the Family "Member/Volunteer List", locate the member to add animal information to and select "Edit". From the top of the screen, click on "Animals/Livestock"



In this section you can Add Animals and Print reports (PDF or Excel once animals have been entered). Fill out the information in as much detail as possible. You also have the opportunity to upload pictures of most your animals as well. Once complete, SAVE all information!
