

Colorado Youth Meat Quality Assurance Certification Form

All 4-H/FFA members who are exhibiting market and/or breeding animal projects must sign/return this form to the Extension Office.

The member/family agrees and consents to abide by the rules of competition and will be in compliance with the proper, labeled use of medications and additives as required under the USDA Wholesome Meat Act. Additionally, all 4-H members and parents/guardians should have signed a Code of Conduct for participation in Colorado 4-H events. Conduct not in keeping with high 4-H standards will not be tolerated. Violation of items listed in the Code of Conduct will result in consequences which may include removal from participation in future 4-H events. Please be aware of the proper conduct for participating in 4-H events.

Our signatures indicate that the 4-H/FFA member has attended a Meat Quality Assurance program *at least 45 days prior* to their county fair, completed the training, will abide by the 10 Good Production Practices listed on the back of this form, and is thus permitted to participate in Colorado 4-H/FFA market and/or breeding animal projects. Consequences for failing to be in compliance with the Wholesome Meat Act/Rules of Competition/4-H Code of Conduct may result in removal from all 4-H/FFA livestock projects for the member and family.
