



Shooting Sports Packet Important Information Please Read Carefully

Note: Although we hope no adjustments need to be made for COVID-19 restrictions, stay tuned to county emails for updates

Information on Practices:

Attendance

- Must attend **3 practices per discipline**.
- **For Rifle ONLY:** .22 Rifle and Air Rifle are a combined 3 practices.
- **Shotgun** requires 3 practices for trap and a combination of 3 skeet/sporting clays practices.
- Practices **MUST** be completed by **July 6, 2021** (no exceptions) to participate at the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition.

Age Requirements

- Any 4-H Member under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian over the age of 21.
- A 16-year-old member **CANNOT** bring underaged siblings.

Locations

- Official Practice Sites: **Ft. Lupton** (South Platte Valley Historical Society Range), **Galeton** (Weld County Fish and Wildlife Range), **Grover**, and **Great Guns**

Practice Cards

- **MUST be brought to each practice** to get a stamp from a Range Leader.
- **YOU are responsible for getting stamps on your practice card!**
 - It is proof that you attended a practice. No other proof exists.
- If lost, a new card can be received from the Weld County Extension Office but stamps will not be recreated.
- If you come to practice and the practice gets rained out, you will still **receive a stamp and credit for the practice, so come to practice even if the weather is not good.**

Galeton Waiver:

All persons entering the Galeton range must sign a waiver to be on the property. You may be asked to sign a waiver multiple times. When asked to sign, you will need to sign or leave the range.

Suggestion:

Take a picture of your card **EACH TIME** you get a stamp in case it gets lost. No stamps will be reissued without proof.

Hunter Safety

- Hunter Safety is required to participate in the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition.
- You may come to practices even if you have not yet taken your Hunter Education Class.
- However, you **CANNOT** compete at the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition without it. **Hunter's Safety MUST be completed by July 6.**

Safety Day Training

- You **MUST** attend Safety Day for **EACH** new discipline
- Participants can get training for multiple disciplines at Safety Day.

Note: Safety Day must be repeated for any disciplines youth do not participate in the year trained.

Important Discipline Specific Information

Shotgun:

- ☞ Prices will be:
 - \$6.00 per round at Grover
 - \$15 for 50 rounds of sporting clays at Great Guns

.22 Pistol:

- ☞ Participants **MUST** be enrolled as an **INTERMEDIATE** (11-13) **WITH AT LEAST 1 YEAR OF AIR PISTOL EXPERIENCE** or a **SENIOR** (14-18) to participate in this discipline.
- ☞ You **MUST** have attended a **.22 Pistol Safety Day** to participate.
- ☞ The State rules can be found at the state site: www.co4hshooting.org.
- ☞ You **MUST** have a **signed permission slip with you at all times** while at the range. A copy of the required slip can be found at the state site: www.co4hshooting.org.

Nationals: (Seniors Only)

- ☞ Air Pistol, Compound Archery, Recurve Archery, Muzzleloader, and .22 Pistol use highest state scores to determine qualification
- ☞ Shotgun uses aggregate scores from Trap, Skeet, and Sporting Clays
- ☞ .22 Rifle uses aggregate scores from Hunt and Sporter/4P*
- ☞ Air Rifle uses aggregate scores from Utility and Sporter/4P*

*State requirements for air rifle and .22 rifle may be changing. Look to the state rules for any updates.

Weld County Shooting Sports Competition (County Shoot)

July 17-18, 2021

Registration:

- ✎ The Weld County Shooting Sports Competition (often called the County Shoot) and the Weld County Fair and are two separate events
- ✎ **You will need to register separately** for the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition AND the Weld County Fair/Interview Judging entries

Weld County Shooting Sports Competition (County Shoot)

Registration:

- ✎ **DUE WEDNESDAY, JULY 7, 2021**
 - Entries are accepted until 5:00p.m. **Monday, July 12** with a \$5.00 per event late fee
 - NO entries are accepted after 5:00p.m. **JULY 12** OR the day of County Shoot
- ✎ Competition entry information will be **emailed** out in May
- ✎ Entries MUST include your practice card showing 3 stamped practices for each discipline you register for

Weld County Fair/Interview Judging Registration:

- ✎ Register for your project displays and interview judging at www.Weld4h.org OR www.weldcountyfair.com
- ✎ Entries are due on **JULY 9, 2021**
- ✎ You must complete and exhibit a project to be eligible for the State Shoot and any of the 2022 competitions.
- ✎ Fair Book will be available ONLINE in May.

Important Information:

- ✎ There is **NO** early County Shoot day. County Shoot will be **July 17-18, 2021 ONLY**.
- ✎ If you are eligible to compete in the state contest, your display project **MUST** be exhibited at the **Weld County Fair in Greeley**.
