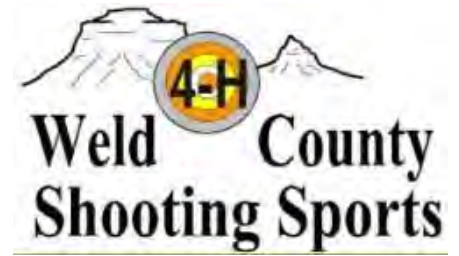


# Shooting Sports Packet

### Please Read Carefully



## Practice Information

### Attendance

- Must attend **3 practices per discipline**
- For Rifle ONLY: Air Rifle and .22 Rifle are a combined 3 practices
- Shotgun: Requires 3 practices for trap and a combination of 3 skeet/sporting clays practices
- Pistol: If doing both Air Pistol and .22 Pistol, members are required to have at least 1 Air Pistol practice and 3 .22 Pistol practices. If doing Air Pistol only, members still need to attend 3 Air Pistol practices. If doing .22 Pistol only, members still need to attend 3 .22 Pistol practices.
- Practices **MUST be completed by July 2, 2024** (no exceptions) to participate at the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition



### Age Requirements

- Any 4-H Member under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian over the age of 21
- A 16-year-old member CANNOT bring underaged siblings



### Range Waivers

- **All persons entering the Galeton range must sign a waiver** to be on the property.
- **All shooters at Ft. Lupton must sign a waiver.**
- You may be asked to sign a waiver multiple times.
- When asked to sign, you will need to sign or leave the range.

### Practice Cards

- MUST be brought to each practice to get a stamp from a Range Leader.
- **YOU are responsible for getting stamps** on your practice card! It is proof that you attended a practice. No other proof exists.
- If lost, a new card can be obtained from the Weld County Extension Office, but stamps will not be recreated!



### Suggestion:

Take a picture of your card EACH TIME you get a stamp in case it gets lost. No stamps will be reissued without proof.



### Rain Outs!

- Assume practice is happening unless you receive an official extension office email saying otherwise. Weather may be different at the range!
- If you come to practice and the practice gets rained out, you will still receive a stamp and credit for the practice, so come to practice even if the weather is not good.

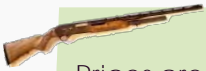

## DISCIPLINE-SPECIFIC INFORMATION



### SHOTGUN

Prices are:

- Skeet/Trap:
  - Galeton: \$5 per round
  - Colorado Clays: \$6 per round
- Sporting Clays:
  - Galeton: \$13 for 50 targets / \$25 for 100 targets
  - Colorado Clays: \$14 for 50 targets



### .22 PISTOL

- Participants **MUST** be enrolled as an INTERMEDIATE (11-13) WITH AT LEAST 1 YEAR OF AIR PISTOL EXPERIENCE or a SENIOR (14-18)
- You **MUST** have a **signed handgun permission form with you any time you are in possession of the pistol.**

# WELD COUNTY FAIR & COUNTY SHOOT

- 🔪 The Weld County Shooting Sports Competition (often called the County Shoot) and the Weld County Fair are two separate events
- 🔪 You will need to register separately for the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition AND the Weld County Fair/Interview Judging entries

## WELD COUNTY FAIR/ INTERVIEW JUDGING

- Register for your projects and interview judging at [www.Weld4h.org](http://www.Weld4h.org) OR [www.weldcountyfair.com](http://www.weldcountyfair.com)
- Entries are due on JULY 8, 2024
- Interview Judging is July 22, 2024
- You must complete and exhibit a project for one of your disciplines to be eligible for the State Shoot and any of the 2025 competitions
- Fair Book will be available ONLINE in May

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- There is NO early County Shoot option.
  - Remember, to complete the project, you MUST display at the Weld County Fair. You are not required to shoot at the County Shoot.
- If you are eligible to compete in the state contest, your display project MUST be exhibited at the Weld County Fair in Greeley.

## COUNTY SHOOT

- July 13 and 14, 2024
  - July 13:
    - Galeton Range: Archery, .22 pistol, .22 rifle, and muzzleloading
  - July 14:
    - Galeton Range: Shotgun
    - Island Grove Exhibition Building: Air rifle and air pistol
- REGISTRATION DUE WEDNESDAY, JULY 3, 2024
- Entries are accepted until 5:00 p.m. Monday, July 8 with a \$5.00 per event late fee
- NO entries are accepted after 5:00 p.m. JULY 8 OR the day of County Shoot
- Competition entry information will be emailed out in May
- Entries MUST include your practice card showing 3 stamped practices for each discipline you register for

Please note: The extension office will be closed July 4 and 5

## Hunter's Safety

- Hunter's Safety is required to participate in the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition.
- Check the Galeton Range calendar for Hunter's Safety courses. ([www.wcfw.org](http://www.wcfw.org))
- You may come to practices even if you have not yet taken your Hunter Education Class.
- However, you CANNOT compete at the Weld County Shooting Sports Competition without it.
- Hunter's Safety MUST be completed by July 3.
